INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), an Indiana corporation, gives notice that on or before October 3, 2022, it will submit for approval under the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission's thirty-day filing process a request for approval of changes to its Demand-Side Management / Energy Efficiency Program Cost Rider allowing a Qualifying Customer electing to opt out of participation in the I&M's Energy Efficiency Program (Opt Out Customer) to opt back into participation in I&M's Energy Efficiency Program by providing notice at any time during the year (rather than the current November 15 deadline of the year prior to its requested opt in date). I&M customers potentially affected by this filing include commercial and industrial opt out customers interested in opting back into I&M's Energy Efficiency Program. Some outdated language related to Opt Out timing was also removed or rewritten to reflect the current Opt Out process. A decision on the thirty-day filing should be received from the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission on or before November 2, 2022.
