

LEGAL NOTICE

INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), an Indiana corporation, gives notice that on or before September 30, 2022, it will submit for approval under the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission's thirty-day filing process a request to approve a change to Tariff L.G.S. The proposed modification to this tariff is to add a 60-kW minimum peak demand over the previous 12-month period to be eligible to enroll in Tariff L.G.S. This is an effort to correct a scribe error in the tariff sheet that was approved in I&M's most recent Indiana rate case number 45576. This new eligibility criteria will not affect any customers currently on Tariff L.G.S. and will not affect the rates of current or future customers on this tariff. I&M customers potentially affected by this filing include those interested in enrolling in Tariff L.G.S. in the Indiana service territory of I&M in the future. The new eligibility requirement would go into effect once approved by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission. A decision on this matter is expected on or before November 9, 2022.
