

LEGAL NOTICE

INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), an Indiana corporation, gives notice that it will submit an updated Rider D.R.S.2 (Demand Response Service-Economic) for approval, under the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission's thirty-day filing process, on or before February 27, 2026. The updates clarify customer responsibilities for submitting offers, monitoring awards and dispatch, and removing resources from other markets to avoid double counting, and require Curtailment Service Providers (CSPs) serving DRS2 customers to execute contracts with the Company. Credits and charges are revised to reflect PJM settlement items: customers will be responsible for 100% of PJM charges, including administrative fees, and the Curtailment Credit is expanded to include Balancing Operating Reserve credits. Customers potentially affected by this filing include all customers registered for service under Rider D.R.S.2 located in the Indiana jurisdiction of I&M's service territory. A decision on I&M's proposed revisions to Rider D.R.S.2 is expected from the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission on or before April 1, 2026.
