INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), an Indiana corporation, gives notice that on or before February 26, 2021, it will submit for approval under the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission's thirty-day filing process proposed modifications to Riders D.R.S.1 (Demand Response Service-Emergency) and D.R.S.3 (Demand Response Service-Ancillary). The proposed modifications will provide credit rates for the 2021/2022 delivery year for D.R.S.1 and provide revised D.R.S.3 language consistent with PJM changes in rules and regulations and I&M current operating practices.

Customers potentially affected by this filing include commercial and industrial customers located in I&M's Indiana service territory currently participating or considering enrolling into one of the subject programs. A decision on the proposed modifications to Riders D.R.S.1 and D.R.S.3 is expected from the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission on or before March 31, 2021.
