INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), an Indiana corporation, gives notice that on or before April 1, 2021, it will submit for approval under the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission's thirty-day filing process a request to approve an updated monthly per kWh rate for I&M's Green Power Rider, Local Renewable Program option, to be effective the first billing cycle of the month following a decision in this case. The referenced filing will consist of Indiana Michigan Power Company's calculation of the new per kWh rate based on the average rate of the New Jersey Class I Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) prices over the six month period of September 1, 2020 through February 28, 2021 as published in S&P Global Renewable Energy Certificate Index. I&M customers potentially affected by this filing include those interested in voluntarily supporting the development of electricity generated by renewable energy resources by subscribing to purchase renewable energy certificates under the IM Green Rider Local Renewable option. A decision on the updated IM Green Rider per kWh renewable energy certificate pricing based on the New Jersey Class I REC should be received from the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission on or before May 5, 2021.
