INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), an Indiana corporation, gives notice that on or before May 22, 2026, it will submit for approval under the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission's (Commission) thirty-day filing process, a request to modify I&M's Terms and Conditions of Service that are currently on file with the Commission. This filing is made in accordance with Ind. Code § 8-1-2-4.7, which requires electric utilities, beginning with the first monthly billing cycle that begins after June 30, 2026, to apply a levelized billing plan to all active customer accounts that are eligible for, and have applied for, assistance from a home energy assistance program administered under Ind. Code 4-4-33, and to which a levelized billing plan does not already apply. I&M customers potentially affected by this modification are residential customers who receive service from I&M under Tariff R.S. (Residential Electric Service). A decision on the modification of the Terms and Conditions of Service language should be received from the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission on or before June 24, 2026.
